What makes Molok[®] stand out is the emptying method. Molok[®] containers are emptied through the bottom of a reusable lifting liner using a hydraulic arm. This emptying technique offers key benefits not available with conventional containers. Because waste is being lifted out instead of being tipped, the smelly, insect attracting drippings of waste that are common with the tipping method of collection, are non-existent with the Molok[®] system. The crane-lifted emptying method keeps the container, user lid and surroundings clean. As the hydraulic lifting arm can reach up to 7m away from the truck in almost any direction, Molok[®] containers can be placed behind shrubs, sidewalks, fences, even in tight spaces. Additionally, Molok[®] containers can be surrounded with landscaping, pavement or any accessory that suits the area.
